


Google originally said employees would return to its San Francisco Bay Area base on July 6, 2020, then pushed that date to September. Now, Google is extending its employee work-from-home policy through June 2021.

Facebook

Zuckerberg told employees in late May that many would be able to work from home indefinitely, and plans to keep staff remote through 2020.

Mastercard

Mastercard does not plan to implement a formal return to the office anytime soon. In May, it said employees can remain remote until they are comfortable returning.



The Challenge

It's hard to communicate remotely

- Use Project Management Tools to facilitate communication and keep discussions documented.
- Invest in online communication ecosystems like chat, video, and a Project Management System.

The Challenge

Remote teams are unreliable and have low retention

- Change your manual hiring process and use a HRM system to collaborate hiring with managers and automate onboarding tasks.
- Use content checking software for deliverables.
- Provide health and wellness benefits.

The Challenge

Remote workers are difficult to manage and keep accountable

- Use a time tracking and productivity monitoring tool.
- Clarify responsibilities and keep good record using tools that help focus and monitor productivity.
- Build a culture of transparency by keeping all tasks/jobs in a Project Management tool.

The Challenge

It's hard to pay remote workers

- Use payroll software to keep good records and enable accurate reporting for tax filing purposes.
- Schedule automatic payroll.

The Challenge

Remote work is a security risk

- Use a password manager and a VPN.
- Install an antivirus and keep it updated.
- Make a habit of locking your phone and laptop and set them to lock automatically when idle.
- Get virtual insurance.


